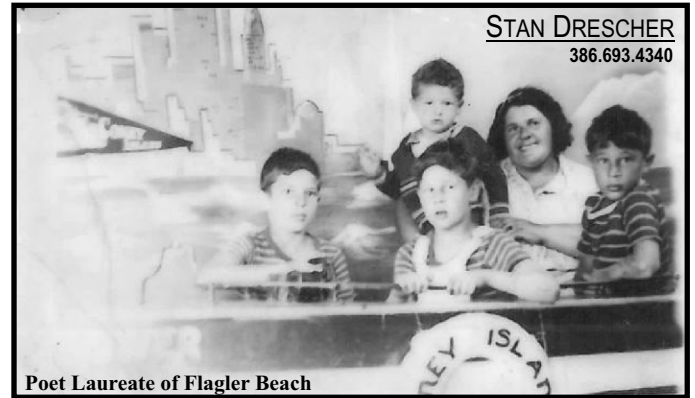
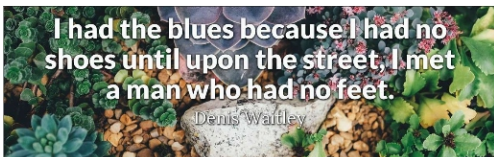
## Shoe Drive...
